Format & Scoring:

10 restricted responses (1/2 mark each) = 5 marks

N.B. The entry test forms five (5) marks of the teacher's assessment.

CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT TESTS [1st and 2nd]

Purpose: to identify deficiencies and prepare the students for success in terminal examinations.

Format & Scoring:

This is an important document for your referencing, kindly keep as such.

- i. **Section A:** 30 multiple choice items (1 mark each) = 30 marks
- ii. **Section B:** 5 restricted response items (3 marks each) = 15 marks
- iii. Aggregate shall be the average of the two sections of the test comprising the multiple choice and the restricted response format. **Total = 15 marks**
- iv. **[N.B. 1st AND 2nd C.A. TESTS = 30 marks]**

PROJECT

Purpose: to prepare the students for standard higher learning and to encourage personalized instructions.

APA FORMAT Example:

- 1. Surname, 2. Initials, 3. Year of publication, 4. Title in italics, 5. edition, 6. city of publication and 7. publisher.

Format & Scoring:

- i. 1 extended response questions = 10 marks
 - ii. Project title = 1 mark
 - iii. Introduction = 1 mark
 - iv. Content Sufficiency = 5 marks
 - v. Conclusion = 1 mark
 - vi. Appropriate use of APA reference = 2 marks [meaning every student with appropriate reference earns 2 marks even when content is insufficient]
- Total = 10 marks**

TEACHER'S ASSESSMENT

Purpose: as indicator of students' readiness to learn.

Format & Scoring:

- i. Entry test = 5 marks
 - ii. C.E.C i.e. test items solutions = 2 marks (1st& 2nd C.A. C.E.C)
 - iii. Marked Class notes = 2 marks
 - iv. Organized annotated charts = 1
- Total = 10 marks**

TERMINAL EXAMINATION

Purpose: for placement

Format & Scoring:

- i. 50 multiple choice items (1 mark each) = 50 marks
- ii. 5 restricted response items (10 marks each) = 50 marks
- iii. Aggregate (50marks) shall be the average of the two sections of the examination comprising the multiple choice and the restricted response format.

Total = 50marks
